

# Flashcards

## American Sign Language

The following activity can be implemented into classrooms in which students have speech-language deficits, are unable to communicate their messages through verbal speech and/or would benefit from learning supplementary communication skills.

Most of these activities involve giving students hands-on materials that can be manipulated, helping students with identification and recognition.

You will also find enrichment ideas that include how you could use other VariQuest templates and shapes to enhance each lesson and/or bridge it to connect to other curriculum areas.

**NOTE:**

For all Cutout Maker e-Dies, cold laminate the construction paper prior to cutting out to create longer-lasting manipulatives that can be re-used or sent home for additional reinforcement.

For all posters, cold laminate and use dry-erase markers to write on and wipe off to re-use and foster interactive learning with students.

## OBJECTIVE

Students will become familiar with the signed letters used by individuals with hearing impairments.

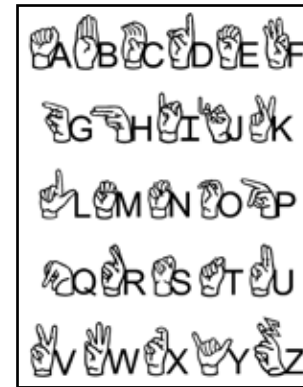
## MATERIALS

ASL flash cards (A-Z)

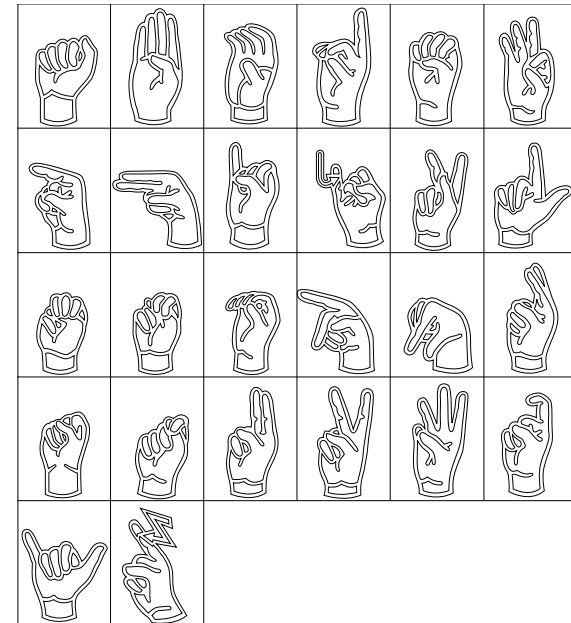
## PREPARATION

Cut out e-Die shapes for the American Sign Language Alphabet A-Z (shown). Glue each sign onto a 4X6 (or similar size) index card, laminate.

Use Poster Maker template: Sign Language Alphabet (shown) to print poster with all ASL signs.

## ACTIVITIES

- Mix up all alphabet flashcards. Pick one flashcard from the pile and practice making the sign for the appropriate letter.
- Place the flashcard on the poster in alphabetical order.
- Repeat with all flashcards until the student has practiced each letter in the alphabet.
- Once all of the flash cards have been placed in the appropriate spot on the poster, practice making the sign for each letter, in alphabetical order. Use poster as guide if necessary.
- Hang ASL Alphabet poster in the classroom for reference.

## ENRICHMENT

- Use e-Die Alphabet Cards (shown) as flashcards to reinforce ASL signs for the letters in the alphabet. Create flashcards for each of the letters in the alphabet and show to student one at a time. Have student make the sign for the corresponding letter in sign language. Use Sign Language Alphabet poster as a visual aid initially, over time ask student to make sign from memory recall only.
- Create a memory game using the ASL flash cards and Alphabet Cards. Place all cards face down on a table. Take turns flipping cards over, two at a time, and trying to match the sign for each letter on the ASL flash card with the appropriate letter/shape on Alphabet Card. Keep track of all successful matches, and tally up the winner once all ASL cards have been matched with their corresponding Alphabet Card.
